Course Description: This class will allow students to develop Basic English vocabulary and grammatical structures so that they can successfully communicate. Every topic will develop students' Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing skills.

Listening: Students will listen to English from native speakers via their teacher and other media (radio and songs). They must focus their attention on the speaker's message in order to comprehend and produce a meaningful response.

Speaking: Students will have the daily opportunity to practice speaking in structured conversations. Also, there will be several projects which require the students to present information using newly acquired English skills.

Reading: Students will be reading a variety of modified texts, including PEI Visitors Guide, Anne of Green Gables Junior Reader, the local newspaper and Canadian recipe books. Students will learn various strategies to help them comprehend a text in their second language.

Writing: Students will be writing on a daily basis in a journal, practicing the grammar structures and the new vocabulary.
